What is FNL?

FNL is the airport identifier for the Northern Colorado Regional Airport, one of 12 commercial service airports in the state. Many great things are taking place at FNL including work to further enhance FNL's positive regional economic impact, currently estimated at \$296 million annually. A new airline terminal facility is planned, arriving in 2024 which will provide expanded commercial air service options and community benefits.



Beginning on October 6, 2021, Avelo Airlines will provide flights twice weekly to Hollywood-Burbank Airport (BUR) located in Southern California. This is in addition to the existing "Wingless Flight" United Airlines connection to Denver International Airport.
